He also chaired India's 9th and 10th five-year plan advisory groups on Tax Policy and Administration. He has published in *Journal of Economic Theory*, *Journal of Public Economics*, *National Tax Journal*, *Oxford Economic Papers*, *Oxford Review of Economic Policy*, *Public Finance Quarterly*, *Staff Papers IMF*, and other international and national journals.
